At Redland Elementary School, regular attendance and punctuality are essential for student success. We expect all students to arrive on time and be present every day to maximize learning opportunities.

Tardiness

- School begins promptly at 8:35AM. Students arriving after this time are considered tardy and must report to the office for a tardy pass before going to class.
- Excessive tardiness may result in parent contact, conferences, and potential disciplinary action in accordance with district policies.

Absences

- A parent/guardian must notify the school of an absence by communicating to your child's homeroom teacher, along with a doctor's note or written reason for absence. Upon returning, students must bring a written note or have a parent submit an excuse online.
- Absences due to illness, medical appointments, or family emergencies may be excused with proper documentation.
- Excessive unexcused absences may lead to intervention measures and potential district actions.
