To promote a positive learning environment and school pride, all students at Redland Elementary School are required to follow the uniform policy outlined below.

# **Daily Uniform Requirements:**

**Tops** (Shirts, Blouses, or Polo Shirts):

- Solid red, white, or navy blue (school colors)
- Must have a collar (polo or button-up)
- No logos except the school logo
- Shirts must be tucked in

# **Bottoms** (Pants, Shorts, Skirts, Jumpers):

- Solid khaki or navy blue
- Must fit properly (no sagging or oversized clothing)
- Shorts, skirts, and jumpers must be knee-length or longer

#### Shoes:

- Closed-toe and closed-heel shoes (sneakers recommended)
- No sandals, flip-flops, Crocs, or light-up shoes for safety reasons
- Sweaters, Sweatshirts, and Jackets:
- Solid red, white, or navy blue
- Must be free of large logos or graphics
- Hoods should remain down inside the building
- School-approved Redland Elementary spirit shirt or a plain solid-colored T-shirt
- Navy blue or black athletic shorts/pants
- Sneakers required for safety

#### **Additional Guidelines:**

- Hair neat and well-groomed; no distracting hairstyles
- Jewelry
- Minimal and safe for school activities (no large hoops or excessive accessories)
- Hats & Head Coverings: Only permitted for religious or medical reasons

# **Dress Down Days & Special Events:**

Occasionally, students may participate in dress-down days or themed events. Parents will receive prior notice regarding acceptable attire.

### Non-Compliance Consequences:

- 1. First Offense: Verbal reminder and parent notification
- 2. Second Offense: Parent contact and change of clothing required
- 3. Repeated Offenses: Meeting with administration and possible disciplinary action
